Lyman Corbitt “Mac” McAnally was born in Red Bay, Alabama. His music career began as many, playing the piano and singing in church. By the age of 15, he had composed his first song. He later became a session musician in Muscle Shoals, Alabama. Mac wrote and released his first two albums in 1977 and 1978. The single “It’s a Crazy World” from the second album reached #37 on the charts.



Later in his career, Mac began writing for Jimmy Buffett and co-wrote “Old Flame” with Alabama. In 1987, he and Walt Aldridge co-wrote “Crime and Passion” for Ricky Van Shelton. Both of these tunes were top ten hits.

In 1990, Mac recorded his first top 40 country hit, “Back Where I Come From”.

This song was also released in 1996 by Kenny Chesney. The two of them teamed up on a duet version of this song in 2008.

Mac was inducted into the Nashville Songwriters Hall of Fame in 2007. He has received the CMA award for Musician of the Year every year since 2008. (one of those awards that was handed out earlier).

Mac’s philosophy toward life can be summed up with this quote. “I believe you always have the choice to make things better or make things worse. I want my legacy to be that I always tried to make things better.”
