
Dude, Your Dues are due.

Members are always asking about our "Point System" so we thought this would be a good time to add it to the newsletter.

Tulsa Parrot Head Club's Point System

This is the official TPHC point system as of May 1, 2013. You can earn points by doing the following:

- 2 Points for attending a monthly meeting (You must sign in to get credit)
- **1 Point** for bringing a raffle prize (You must sign the raffle sheet)
- 1 Point for paying your dues on time
- 1 Point for bringing a new member that joins the club
- 3 Points for attending a club event

1 Point - for each hour you volunteer at a club fundraiser. This could be getting donations for the golf tournament or other fundraisers. Of course, working the fundraiser would also qualify. Any TPHC event that you volunteer for would earn points for you. You will be responsible for keeping your own hours and reporting to the secretary for each event.

5 Points - for chairing a committee

7 Points - for Fin Lines editor and Webmaster

10 Points - for serving as an officer

Remember this is an individual point system, not a couple's point system. We are just trying to be fair to everyone in case the club is offered tickets to concerts or promotions related to the new Margaritaville.

We see this as an opportunity to increase our membership and make our club more visible in the community. We also see it as a way to get more members involved in our activities and events.
