We started walking a little bit late, but shortly after 9:00am we finally hit the trail. Twenty parrot heads signed-up for the event and several




Heads Flocked to Tulsa University to participate in the Alzheimer's walk.



We labeled, boxed, and stacked assorted canned vegetables. While it was challenging for some to figure




out how to properly apply the labels, we still managed to label 3,500 pounds of cans. We then moved on to boxing and palatalizing the labeled cans.
