The evening started off a little bit warm, but we had the pool to keep us cool. Once the sun finally began to set, it turned into a beautiful July



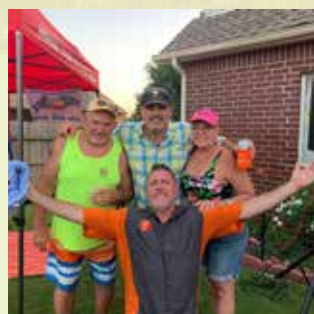

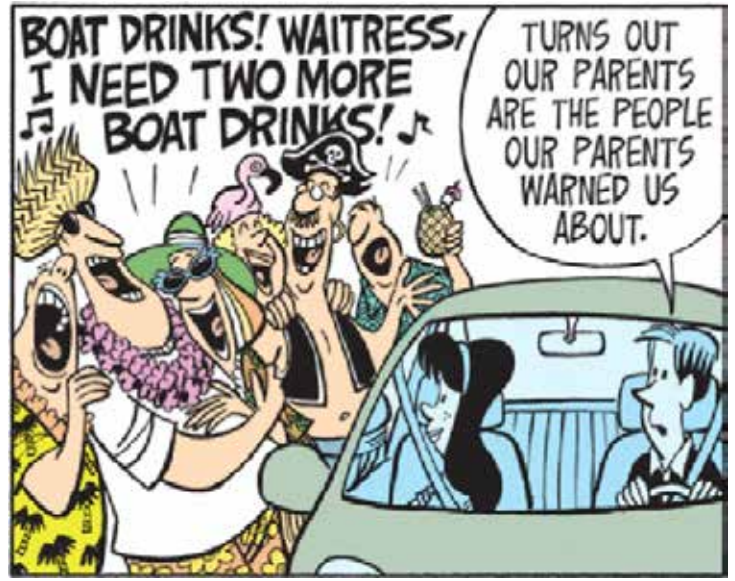
