#### ATTITUDE OF GRATITUDE

An interview with Alex Tirrell Submitted by Don Jones

his month's interview is with Alex Tirrell. Enjoy.

Tell us a bit about yourself. I was born and raised in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and have lived here all my life. My family has always enjoyed music, and my sister and I have both been in choirs most of our lives. When I was eight, a couple friends of mine invited me to join them for a summer sailing camp, and it became a lifelong love of mine. Whenever I can, I sail my small boats out of Windycrest Sailing Club on Keystone Lake. For high school I attended Tulsa School of Arts and Sciences, which at the time, was tiny and was housed in a rented office building. Now it's expanded to cover middle school as well, and both my children attend!

How did you get involved with the Tulsa Parrot Head *Club?* When I was 19, I was looking through my parents CDs, finding ones that seemed interesting and ripping them to my laptop. One of them was Songs You Know by Heart. The cover caught my attention, so I listened to it and I found myself wanting to hear more! All of Buffett's songs resonated with me, and I soon learned about Parrot Heads and their clubs. Unfortunately, the local club usually met at bars, so I wasn't able to join yet. For my 21st birthday, my parents gifted me a Tulsa Parrot Head Club membership. I was finally able to spend time with other people who shared my love of Jimmy's music! When I was 22, I met my now wife, who had heard some of his music on the radio, but really wasn't a fan. I listened to it around her and she came to realize that there's a lot more to Jimmy than just Margaritaville and 5 O'clock Somewhere! She quickly fell in love with his music and we began attending Parrot Head meetings and concerts together.

How many Buffett concerts have you attended? Which was your favorite? I think I've been to ten Buffett concerts. The best one, for sure, was when he played at the Casa Marina one of the years we attended Meeting of the Minds. There's just such a different feel when the audience is around 1,500 people.

What is your favorite Buffett tune? I definitely cannot pick a single favorite tune, but my favorite album is Take the Weather With You. It has a good chunk of my favorite songs, including Bama Breeze, Party at the End of the World, and Breathe In, Breathe Out, Move On.

If there was suddenly no more Buffett music, what would be on your playlist? I listen to a lot of sea shanties and folk music, especially Irish folk music.

What is your favorite Parrot Head activity? I really like getting together with other folks who enjoy the music. It's a big part of what always

made Meeting of the Minds so enjoyable (besides being in Key West!) Just being surrounded by other people who are there for the music and enjoy the same things you do is wonderful. Our club president has a Parrot Head party at her house every year. It's like a mini MoTM that I don't have to catch a flight in order to attend!

What do you do to Chillax? At the end of the day I like to stretch out on the couch with my laptop, my dog (whose name is Skip Wiley), some bourbon, and play various video games. When I'm in the mood for a different kind of relaxation, I'll drive to the lake and stretch out on my sailboat, still with Skip, but (usually) without the bourbon, and just sail around the lake with my toes in the water.

What is something that most Parrot Heads don't know about you? Probably that I was the first Parrot Head in the family! It wasn't until I joined that my parents started listening to Jimmy's music and joined the Tulsa Parrot Head Club.

Now, it's time for the goofy question. If you could be reincarnated, what would you be? I think I'd like to be reincarnated as a cat. They have it pretty good!

**Do you have any closing comments?** I wish I had attended more of Jimmy's concerts. All those times when it didn't quite work out, I wish I had found a way to make it work. But even with him gone, I still plan to keep the party going. Fins up!


