The bus will be starting and ending at the Twin Peaks North OKC located at 3109 W Memorial Rd. Plan to get there at about 10:30am to get a head start on signing in and picking up your T-shirts (for those who purchase a shirt or shirts). Then have some lunch and a beverage. We will load the bus at 11:45am and depart at noon. We will return at around 9:30pm.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT PARKING AT TWIN PEAKS:

Please do not park in the main parking lot of Twin Peaks. You will see a parking lot directly behind (North) of the restaurant. There are plenty of parking spaces in that area and that is where we will be boarding the bus. This will also be the final stop at the end of the night.
