Have you Volunteered YET?! Thank you to everyone who volunteered to help work at the Golf Tournament this year. All volunteers should have received an email informing you of your golf tournament responsibilities. When things get busy and chaotic just remember our goal. We are raising money for Tulsa Cerebral Palsy Association and Special Olympics.

Volunteers need to arrive at the golf course by 7:00am. Those working golf holes should bring chairs, table, music, decorations, canopy, sunscreen etc. Each volunteer hole should provide some type of drink, or shot. Talk with others working your hole to decide who will bring what.

Drinks cannot be "sold", but they are donated to the golfers. We will accept monetary donations. We encourage at least a \$1 donation for each drink or shot. 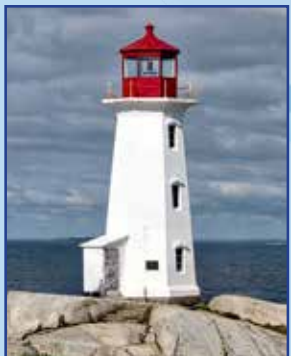
